3.40.010 **DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN ONE THOUSAND FEET OF SCHOOL PROPERTY:**

No person or members of a corporation, firm or organization shall discharge any firearm or any apparatus capable of propelling a missile, including but not limited to any air rifle or gun, CO₂ rifle or gun, slingshot or bow and arrow, within one thousand (1,000) feet of school property. (*Ordinance #93-1/January 15, 1993*)

.01 Apparatus capable of firing a missile, exclusive of firearms, may be operated on one's own property and upon the property of another, with the consent of the owner, provided the projectile discharged at no time crosses the boundary of the property; (*Ordinance #93-1/January 15, 1993*)

.02 Nothing in this Chapter shall prohibit any federal, state, county, or city law enforcement officer from discharging a firearm while in the lawful performance of such officer's duties. (*Ordinance #93-1/January 15, 1993*)

3.40.020 **VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES:** The penalty for violating the provisions of this Chapter shall be as set forth in Chapter 1.75. (*Ordinance #98-6/July 24, 1998*)
